Privacy is a priority to the Recreation Council of Greater St. Louis. We are committed to preserving the privacy of all our visitors to our website.

The Recreation Council does track the number of visitors to our website but we do not collect individual information (email addresses, personal information, etc.) unless the visitor provides us this information elsewhere on our website and only by the expressed permission of the website visitor.

When the visitor makes a donation to the Recreation Council using our website, we collect specific information that is used to process and acknowledge your kind donation. We do not release this information to any third parties without your permission, except for the express purpose of processing your donation.

When you have requested our mailings or email announcements, the Recreation Council uses this contact information specifically for the purpose expressed. We do not share your personal information with anyone not directly affiliated with the Recreation Council without your permission.

The Recreation Council uses security measures that protect against the loss, misuse or alteration of the information under our control. We use a secure server and transmit sensitive information using the secure socket layer (SSL) encryption protocol. All systems are protected by a firewall and secure restricted access for your protection.
