Incorporated in 1983, The Recreation Council of Greater St. Louis is a not-for-profit organization which serves as a “clearinghouse” for information regarding recreation and leisure opportunities for St. Louis City, St. Louis County and St. Charles County residents with disabilities. The Council works to ensure that individuals with disabilities are aware of and have opportunities to access and participate in Recreation programs and activities of their choice.



The Council also brings together individuals working in public and non-profit agencies who serve persons with disabilities to coordinate and provide community-based recreation activities. It is the Council’s desire that **ALL** people, regardless of ability, have the opportunity to participate in leisure/recreation programs, of their choice, in the Greater St. Louis area.

* Voucher Programs Allowing individuals with disabilities and their families to make “choices” in a variety of recreation opportunities through self-directed funding.

* Cycle and Golf Cart Programs

Adapted cycles and golf carts placed in the community.

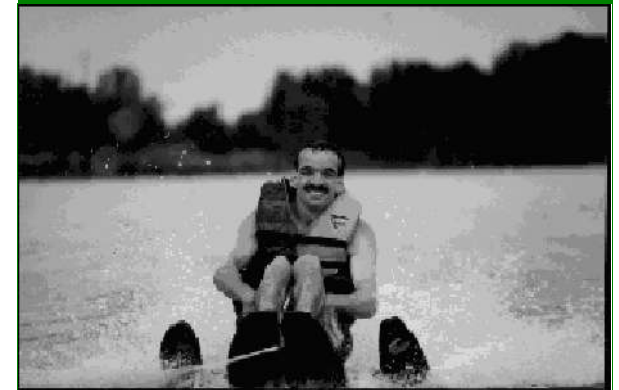
