

## Recommended Professional Development Unit (PDU) Values for Selected Professional Development Activities Certificated Staff

Recommended PDUs have been calculated for the professional development activities listed below. **Unless noted a Professional Development Unit Proposal Form is not required.** A staff member in consultation with the principal/supervisor may earn up to 6 PDUs (of the Board required minimum 10 PDUs) per year through documented participation in these activities.

Selected Professional Development Activities	PDUs Assigned	**Evidence of Completion
1. College courses	3 credit course=3 PDUs Up to 3 of the required 10 PDUs per year can be from college courses.	- grade report
2. Professional Leadership Role <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• state/district/school/community-based committee</li> <li>• professional organization</li> <li>• professional network</li> </ul>	2 PDUs	- meeting log/agendas - description of role, responsibilities and contributions - written reflection on learnings and implications for work
3. Professional Membership & Participation <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• state/district/school/community-based committee</li> <li>• professional organization</li> <li>• professional network</li> </ul>	1 PDU	- information related to the purpose of the committee/ organization/ network - written reflection on learnings and implications for work
4. Conducting/leading professional development at your school (i.e. a study group, training in instructional strategies)	Up to 4 PDUs based on submitting a PD Credit Proposal Form (PD1, PD2) to the Professional Development Academy	- description of content and schedule of sessions - participant feedback summary - description of outcomes/benefits for staff and students
5. Mentoring	Up to 4 PDUs based on established criteria for District Mentor Program	- written reflection on experience and learnings
6. Presenting at a conference/professional meeting	2 PDUs	- conference information with presentation agenda/ handout - written reflection on experience
7. Attending a conference/professional meeting	1 PDU	- conference information with purpose for attending - written reflection on learnings/ sessions and connection to work/SIP - sharing with staff
8. Supervising student teacher fulltime as defined by the college/university	2 PDUs per semester	- written reflection on experience and learning
9. Individually selected professional development	Up to 6 PDUs based on submitting a PD Credit Proposal Form (PD1, PD2) to the Professional Development Academy	- schedule of sessions/activities - description of activity and outcomes/benefits for staff and students - written reflection on experience and learnings

\*\* PDUs are earned upon submitting the agreed upon evidence of completion to the principal/supervisor
