

# EVALUATION FORM FOR WOODWORKING (WO-1,4)

## WO-1 BASIC WOODWORKING

This classification includes projects which are made to be mounted on a wall or placed on a piece of furniture. A single entry may consist of more than one piece, if they form pairs or are matched sets having the same function, such as a pair of candle holders or a two-piece pattern. The pieces must be clearly marked to show that they belong to a single entry. Entry must include drawing(s). Examples: (Box, tray, wall shelf, or coat rack)

## WO-4 WOOD TURNING

Any wood project on which the major portion of the work is turned is eligible. Entry must include drawing(s).
