The internships last for eight weeks and consist of a 40-hour workweek with attendance at daylong seminars each week. Past interns have had a variety of responsibilities from runners on trading floors to research assistants.

Students who participate in the program are carefully selected based on the following criterion:

- Strong academic standing at a St. Louis-area high school
- St. Louis City resident
- The desire to pursue a career in the field of finance

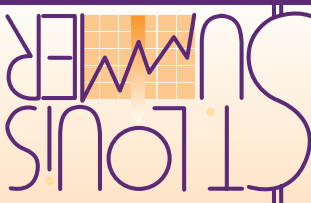

Darlene Green College Scholarship Fund
