

Gateway Mall Introduction

The Gateway Mall Steering Committee is overseeing a master planning process for the Gateway Mall, the ribbon of green space bisecting downtown St. Louis. From the river to the end of the Mall three efforts are underway to determine the feasibility of a new central riverfront; decking a portion of the depressed lanes of I-70 between the Arch & the Old Courthouse; & the Mall visioning process.

The Gateway Mall has evolved through a series of uncoordinated actions. The master plan process will create a roadmap for how the space can evolve into an active civic space that offers a range of experiences for residents & visitors alike. We are looking to create expanded opportunities for civic events; exhibition space; formal & informal activities. The plan will guide future decisions makers.
