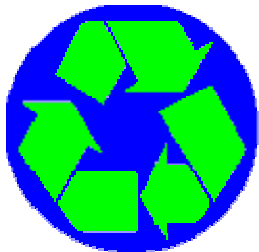


**MONDAY/THURSDAY
HOLIDAY COLLECTION SCHEDULE**
YARD WASTE WILL NOT BE COLLECTED DURING WEEKS WITH A HOLIDAY!

Changes in the trash collection for holiday weeks are as follows:

Labor Day	Monday, September 3, 2007	Tuesday, 09/04/07 & Thursday, 09/06/07

Thanksgiving Day	Thursday, November 22, 2007	Monday, 11/19/07 & Wednesday, 11/21/07
Christmas Day	Tuesday, December 25, 2007	Monday, 12/24/07 & Thursday, 12/27/07
New Year's Day	Tuesday, January 1, 2008	Monday, 12/31/07 & Thursday, 01/03/08
Dr. M.L. King Day	Monday, January 21, 2008	Tuesday, 01/22/08 & Thursday, 01/24/08
President's Day	Monday, February 18, 2008	Tuesday, 02/19/08 & Thursday, 02/21/08
Memorial Day	Monday, May 26, 2008	Tuesday, 05/27/08 & Thursday, 05/29/08
Independence Day	Friday, July 4, 2008	Monday, 06/30/08 & Wednesday, 07/02/08
Labor Day	Monday, September 1, 2008	Tuesday, 09/02/08 & Thursday, 09/04/08

PLEASE NOTE: Yard waste will be collected each Wednesday (except holiday weeks) until December 5, 2007. Weekly yard waste pick-up will resume March 5, 2008. If you must dispose of grass clippings, do not place unbagged clippings in the bottom of the cart. To avoid sticking, either put clippings in a bag (paper bags are preferred) in the bottom or place bulkier yard waste, such as leaves or branches, at the bottom of the cart. Yard waste will **NOT** be collected from the roll carts from December 5, 2007 until March 5, 2008.
