

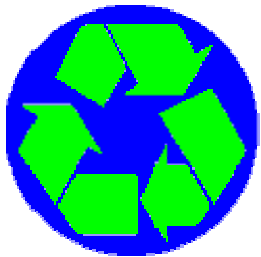
## MONDAY/THURSDAY HOLIDAY COLLECTION SCHEDULE

YARD WASTE WILL NOT BE COLLECTED DURING WEEKS WITH A HOLIDAY!

**Changes in the trash collection for holiday weeks are as follows:**

Christmas Day	Friday, December 25, 2009	Monday, 12/21/09 & Wednesday, 12/23/09
New Year's Day	Friday, January 1, 2010	Monday, 12/28/09 & Wednesday, 12/30/09
Dr. M.L. King Day	Monday, January 18, 2010	Tuesday, 1/19/10 & Thursday, 1/21/10
President's Day	Monday, February 15, 2010	Tuesday, 2/16/10 & Thursday, 2/18/10
Memorial Day	Monday, May 31, 2010	Tuesday, 6/01/10 & Thursday, 6/03/10
Independence Day	Monday, July 5, 2010	Tuesday, 7/6/10 & Thursday, 7/08/10
Labor Day	Monday, September 6, 2010	Tuesday, 9/07/10 & Thursday, 09/09/10

**PLEASE NOTE:** Yard waste will be collected each Wednesday (except holiday weeks) until December 2, 2009. Weekly yard waste pick-up will resume March 3, 2010. If you must dispose of grass clippings, do not place unbagged clippings in the bottom of the cart. To avoid sticking, either put clippings in a bag (paper bags are preferred) in the bottom or place bulkier yard waste, such as leaves or branches, at the bottom of the cart. Yard waste will NOT be collected from roll carts from December 2, 2009 until March 3, 2010.
