I Benjamin F. Buchanan of the City of St. Louis, State of Missouri, being of sound mind and memory, do hereby make, publish and declare this to be my last Will and testament, hereby revoking any and all wills by me heretofore made.

First: I direct my Executor, hereinafter named to pay, out of my Estate all my just debts and funeral expenses, as soon as may be after my decease.

Second: I give devise and bequeath unto my Children, Oscar F. Buchanan, Anna Amanda Bennett wife of W. D. Bennett, Alonzo Buchanan, Edward E. Buchanan, Martha Jane Johnson wife of James R. Johnson and Laura E. Mc Lane wife of Octavine C. Mc Lane the sum of One dollar each; also to my two grandchildren Samuel Swan and Ollie Swan children of my daughter Evaline Swan deceased, the sum of One dollar each.

Third: I give, devise and bequeath unto my son William D. Buchanan absolutely and forever all the remainder of my property and estate, real, personal and mixed wheresoever situate, and whatsoever consisting of. To Have and to Hold the same in fee simple.

Fourth: I hereby nominate, constitute and appoint Charles C. Nicholls of the City of St. Louis State of Missouri the Executor of this my last Will and testament.
