## Judge Makes Appearance at TPNA General Meeting – July 26th

Join us at the TPNA General Membership meeting on **Tuesday, July 26** at 7 p.m. at the **SLPOA Hall, 3710 Hampton** to enhance your understanding of the role of the State Judiciary in St. Louis. Judge Michael Mullen will take questions and comments however he is prohibited from discussing individual cases or giving legal advice.

Judge Mullen has been an Associate Circuit Judge since May 2000, having been appointed by Governor Bob Holden. He is presently assigned to hear Jury Trials that arise from Criminal Misdemeanor charges. Prior to that, he spent two years in Family Court. Before being appointed to the bench, Judge Mullen was engaged in the private practice of law as a trial attorney handling both criminal and civil cases. He spent five years as an Assistant Circuit Attorney and has taught criminal law as an adjunct professor at UMSL. He received both his undergraduate and law degrees from the University of Missouri, Columbia. Judge Mullen and his wife, Joan, have four children and are active members of St. Gabriel the Archangel Parish.
