The event is open to all Tilles Park neighborhood children and the grandchildren of Tilles Park residents. We will also have our Membership table set up to give you the opportunity to join or renew your Tilles Park Neighborhood Association membership with payment of the 2005 dues.

Plans Progress for 8th Taste of Tilles Saturday, June 11th

Tantalizing tastes will be provided by **Bartolino's, Bastante, Bellacino's, Biggie's, Chris', LeGrand's, LoRusso's, Pietro's, Spiro's Central and Sweet Life** (as of press time). Shuttle buses will operate 11 a.m. to 3 p.m. from the Tilles Park Playground to participating restaurants along Hampton, Chippewa and Watson. From 2-4 p.m., there will be a free concert in Tilles Park featuring the fantastic big band sounds of **Second Generation Swing**, a 17-piece orchestra. TPNA will sell **Five Taste tickets in advance \$10 and event day \$15**. Proceeds from the event are dedicated to Tilles Park improvements. Attention: Pet Owners

In response to increased concerns/complaints, we want to make our residents aware of the ordinance governing walking and cleaning up after pets on the streets and in the parks in the City, and the penalties that can be imposed for any of these violations. Pet owners are responsible for cleaning up after their pets on any sidewalk, public or private area (exception is for guide dogs accompanying the blind). Pets also must be on a leash (6 feet in length) held by or under control of a responsible person on City streets, sidewalks, in a park or any other public area. If Animal Control apprehends an unleashed pet, the owner will be required to pay a \$50 minimum fee. The animal will be spayed/neutered before being returned to the owner.

Penalties for violations:

- 1st violation – Fine \$100-500 and/or 90 days imprisonment
- 2nd violation – Fine of not less than \$300 and/or 90 days imprisonment
- 3rd violation – Fine of not less than \$500 and imprisonment of not less than 10 days

Violators should be reported to the Animal Regulation Center at 353-5838 and/or the Citizen's Service Bureau at 622-4800. If pet owners need a place for their dog to be "unleashed," check out the following three City dog parks:
