## Elder Law and Estate Planning to be the Topic at May 31 Meeting

Ms. Christine Alsop, attorney with Evans & Dixon LLC's Elder Law and Estate Planning to be the keynote speaker at the next TPNA General Membership Meeting set for 7 p.m. Tues., May 31 at the SLPOA Hall, 3710 Hampton.

The meeting is open to the public. Doors will open at 6:30 p.m. to facilitate purchase of Taste of Tilles tickets.

Ms. Alsop will discuss topics concerning healthcare directives, end of life issues, as well as powers of attorney, estate planning, how property is transferred in the State of Missouri, long-term care planning and Medicaid. A question and answer period will follow.

Ms. Alsop specializes in the areas of elder care, estate planning and civil litigation. She earned her undergraduate degree from St. Louis University

with a Bachelor of Arts in Performing Arts. Later she attended Valparaiso University School of Law, where she graduated with scholastic honors. Ms. Alsop is a member of both the Missouri and Illinois Bars and is admitted to practice before the United States Supreme Court. She is actively involved as a member of the National Academy of Elder Law Attorneys, as well as the Missouri Chapter of NAEALA, where she was recently elected to its Board of Directors.
