Be Kind to Your Neighbor – A Friendly Reminder

When using the larger dumpsters in the alleys, which are shared by several households, be neighborly by considering the following:

- ❖ If you have large cardboard boxes – break them down so that they take up less space.
- ❖ If you have items too large for the dumpster, don't lean them against the dumpster so they wind up UNDER the dumpster after the bi-weekly truck pickup and have no way of being removed during the end of the month bulk item pickup. See the schedule posted on your dumpster for large items.
- ❖ If you have an overwhelming amount of trash, consider holding half of the non-perishable items till the second pickup of the week.
- ❖ Last, but not least, use some sort of trash bag that can be closed or tied up. Loose papers tend to fly away into the alley during the pickup. Besides cluttering up the alley, do you really want your neighbors to see that overdue notice or that Victoria Secret's receipt??

Be kind to your neighbors and leave them some space in the dumpsters!!

Pink Pom-Poms Decorate Tilles Park – What are those things on the long stalks?

Earlier this spring, we had many compliments and queries as to what those 'purple-pink pom-pom on a stalk thingys' were growing in Rosalie's Garden. The answer is 'Alliums'! These are indeed related to onions but are grown as ornamentals only. They come in a variety of sizes and colors ranging from bluish purple to rosy pink and white. A few have yellow florets which make up the flower head. Some are solid globes of florets and some resemble fireworks. The dried seed heads are just as interesting as the flowers. Almost all prefer full sun and drier soils.

If you want to add this unique flower to your garden, now is the time to plant them. They are available at your favorite garden center along with other spring bulbs such as tulips and daffodils.
